
**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING  
ABANDONED VEHICLES UPON  
PRIVATE PROPERTY**


**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Town Council of the Town of Blades, in Council met, in the following, to wit:


**AN ACT TO AMEND**, Ordinance 416 by striking paragraph four, adopted by the Town Council on April 9, 2001, and replace with new paragraph to read as follows:


If an abandoned vehicle is on private property with the consent of the owner or occupant thereof, or if the abandoned vehicle is owned by the owner or occupant of the private property where the vehicle is located, said vehicle must be removed from the property by the owner or occupant within 72 hours upon vehicle being placarded. Placarded vehicles not removed may be towed and stored elsewhere at the expense of the owner or occupant. In addition, any person who shall violate this Ordinance or fails to comply with any notice or order issued by a Code Official and/or member of the Blades Police Department shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall not be fined less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both. Each day of a separate and continuing violation shall be deemed a separate offense






