
Significant Event:

- 1. On Tuesday, June 10, 2014, Chief Edwin Cooke attended the Delaware Chiefs' Council meeting held at the Dover Police Department in Dover, Delaware.
- 2. On Wednesday, June 18, 2014, Chief Edwin Cooke attended the Sussex County Police Chiefs' Association meeting held at the Big Daddy's Restaurant in Bridgeville, Delaware.
- 3. On Sunday, June 21, 2014, Magistrate Court Judge Deborah Keenam administered the Oath of Office to John P. Thompson III thereby officially stating the following.
 - I, John P. Thompson III, do solemnly swear that I process the qualifications required by law for the position of Police Officer of the Town of Blades to which I have been awarded, and that I will support the Constitution of the United States of America, the Constitution of the State of Delaware and the Ordinances of the Town of Blades. As a Police Officer for the Town of Blades, I will perform the duties with fidelity and to the best of my ability. I will act in accordance with what I believe to be in the best interest of the Town of Blades and its citizens.
- 4. On Monday, July 7, 2014, Chief Edwin Cooke successfully completed the online academic requirement to attend the two day practical training course to become a certified TASER Instructor for the CEW [conduct electrical weapon]. The two day practical training to be held at W

On Friday, July 11, 2014, Mayor Michael Smith and Chief Edwin Cooke attended the graduation ceremony of the 86th Delaware State Police and the 78th Municipal Police Class held at the Education Humanities Building Delaware State University, Dover, Delaware. Patrolman John P. Thompson III received the outstanding municipal officer of the 78th Municipal Recruit Class presented by the Delaware Police Chiefs' Council chairperson Chief William Topping of Georgetown Police Department.
- 6. Noteworthy...Chief Edwin Cooke conducted a background investigation on applicant Victor A. Matos potential police recruit to attend the 79th Municipal Police Class that is scheduled to start on Monday, September 8, 2014.
- 7. Noteworthy...On Sunday, January 26, 2014, at 1212 hours a masked unknown male suspect entered the Café Milano Restaurant and

displayed a handgun, ordered the owner/victim to open the cash register allowing the suspect to remove the cash from the cash register. Suspect fled the scene on foot. On Saturday, February 1, 2014, the suspect was apprehended within the limits of Blades, arrested and charged with one count of Robbery First, one count of Aggravated Assault and one count of Wearing a Disguise During the Commission of a Felony – defendant appeared at J.P. Court #3 and was committed to Sussex Correctional Institution in default of \$40,000 secured bond. The case was resolved on Wednesday, July 9. 2014, with the defendant sentenced to ten (10) years and six (6) month in jail. Also forfeited are the items seized - collected on the day the incident occurred.
