Council Meeting:

Committee Reports:

- Housing/Code Report submitted by Marcus Trammell, read by Commissioner Reiss.
 Commissioner Reiss thanked Vikki Prettyman, Town Administrator, for getting the dumpsters and the funding for the town clean up and to all the employees who worked on Saturday, June 25th, 2016 and helped our citizens unload their trash.
- Water report submitted by Brandon Slater; read by Commissioner Hardin.
- Streets No written report. Commissioner Joseph stated the patching & paving work on E Second, E Third, W Ninth, and W Fourth Street are being scheduled; the dump truck has new tires; there is a dumpster in the water tower fenced area due to the trees being trimmed are being dumped into it for easier clean up;
- Parks & Cemetery Commissioner Ruff stated that the guys are trimming the trees in the park and cemetery; the cemetery is getting cut on schedule; and the unofficial update on the fire companies new station fire siren is installed just not working at the moment, waiting on connectivity; some delays in opening due to construction issues; maybe September or October.
