HUD-VASH

- HUD-VASH provides permanent housing for eligible homeless single Veterans and homeless Veterans with families. Services include on-going case management that provides*:
 - Budget management
 - Resource coordination
 - Periodic transportation
 - Help with housing search
 - Links to mental health and substance abuse treatment
 - Help with employment searches
 - Connection to Veteran Benefits
 - Access to community providers and other VA facilities

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

- Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) focuses on providing services to Veteran families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Services include*:
 - o Case management
 - Assistance with obtaining VA and public benefits
 - Employment Assistance
 - Rental Assistance
 - o Security Deposit Assistance
 - Utility Assistance

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PARTNERSHIP BENEFITS

Landlords gain several benefits from using HUD-VASH and SSVF resources. Consider the following advantages:

Guaranteed income

Receive reliable monthly rental payments*

Security deposits:

Veterans can often afford the monthly rent, but have difficulty saving enough money for their security deposit. As a result of their enrollment in HUD-VASH or SSVF, veterans may be eligible to receive this one-time payment.

Eliminate advertising costs

Working with these programs gives you access to a pool of ready-to-rent tenants

• Case management

Veterans have access to a case manager to train them on such topics as personal budgeting, understanding rental agreements, housekeeping and general apartment maintenance, being a good neighbor, etc. resulting in less turnover.

Satisfaction from helping others

Everyone deserves a safe and affordable place to live. Housing Delaware Veterans plays an integral role in helping Veterans and their families take charge of their lives, as well as making Delaware a better place to live.
