RESOLUTION 20.25.01

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MITIGATION ACTION INTO THE MITIGATION PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF BLADES

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as amended, requires that local governments develop and adopt natural hazard mitigation plans in order to receive certain federal assistance, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Blades is vulnerable to damages from hazard events that pose a threat to public health and safety and could result in property loss and economic hardship, and

WHEREAS, a Multi-Jurisdictional All-Hazards Mitigation Plan Update (the Plan) has been developed through the work of Sussex County Hazard Mitigation Working Group and interested parties within the Town of Blades, and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (P.L. 106-390) (DMA 2000) and associated Federal regulations published under 44 CFR (Code of Regulations) Part 201 require the Town of Blades to formally adopt an All-Hazard Mitigation Plan Update subject to approval of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to be eligible for federal fund for hazard mitigation projects and activities.

WHEREAS, public meetings were held to receive comments on the Plan as required by DMA 2000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BLADES, that the Sussex County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan dated December 2022 and as approved by the Delaware Emergency Management Agency, is hereby adopted as an official plan of the Town of Blades.
